Recent green bonds and green loans to promote the financing of metals recycling projects

Stena Metall Group (2018) and **Aurubis** (2020) issuing green bonds to finance their recycling activities.

Polymetal (2020) procuring a green loan from Société Générale to support the company's environmental goals, which includes recycling a minimum of 16% of waste generated by 2023.

Elemental Holding (2021), a member of both the European Raw Materials Alliance and the European Battery Alliance, securing financing from EBRD for up to €25 million to finance the construction of a battery recycling project in Poland. The project will be the first battery recycling project in the European Union.
